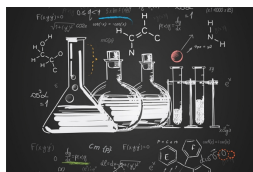


SPRING SEMESTER 2023

Tutoring is available Sunday through Thursday evenings in the Math/Science Community Learning Center ["Fishbowl"]



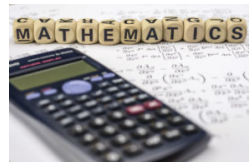

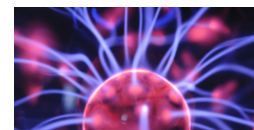
